RE: Resident and Local Sport User Impact & No Anchor Zones

Please be considerate of Amalga and Huffman Harbor residents as well as local users of the Amalga boat launch. The long-term success of seine opportunity at Amalga is dependent upon how the commercial fishing fleet conducts themselves while in the area.

Please do not leave skiffs unattended at the boat launch dock, do not unload trash in the sport launch harbor area, and please keep noise to a minimum before and after the open hours of the fishery.

See attached **no anchor zones** for tenders and seine vessels to avoid tangling with DIPAC's net pen anchors and ground lines. Please note -the image in this document is the entire SHA for cost recovery. Please wait for the ADF&G announcement for THA lines for the common property opener.

DIPAC will be conducting Cost Recovery through Monday 6/29. For Sunday & Monday, do not anchor near Kishbrock Island or in Eagle Harbor until cost recovery is complete.

No Anchoring Zone – Amalga Harbor

DIPAC has 17 anchors and many supporting groundlines in the vicinity of Amalga Harbor for securing our net pen complex while rearing chum. To allow for seine harvesting in the SHA, we sink the lines and attach shore ties.

To avoid damaging these lines or your own anchor/anchor chain, please do not anchor and ask that no Tenders Vessels anchor in the following area:
